## Subject area career offer

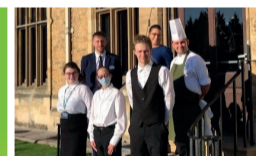
Teachers will embed career-related events and activities into class, to run alongside your course. They will also book the careers team to deliver information on progression routes.



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## Meeting employer and employee guest speakers

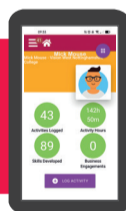
Chances to chat with employers to find out about their career journey, the career opportunities in their organisations as well as trips and visits to be able to step into a business environment.
